Presentation Description:

This presentation will discuss the trends in suicide rates in this country and the current research. Participants will learn how to assess a specific patient according to the patient's own particular baseline for suicidal ideation as well as assessing the patient in comparison to other patients in their current practice. These two types of assessment help the clinician make a more effective decision on immediate treatment intervention when meeting with a patient presenting with suicidal ideation. All clinicians must be well versed in the serious risk of suicidal behavior, and this presentation will assist clinicians in feeling more competent in assessment and documentation.
