WHAT'S NEXT?

Math is the upcoming rotation. In this block, there will be an emphasis on problem-solving and critical thinking. Students will work on mathematics content at their grade level to:

- Work individually and collaboratively (in small groups) to solve a problem).
- Find the correct solution to a problem and label the answer appropriately.
- Provide explanations and justifications for solutions.
- Make sense of other's solutions.
- Choose appropriate problem solving strategies for different types of problems.
- Describe ways problem solving strategies are used in real-world applications.
- Explore career opportunities in STEM related fields.



ENGLISH 7-10

During this rotation, students studied spoken word poetry. Our students worked hard to learn about what makes spoken word poetry different from other kinds of poetry, and even held their own poetry slam. The students all performed their revised, final poems for their classmates. While studying poetry we also learned about literary devices and how to do close readings of poetry.

ENGLISH 11-12

Our grades 11 and 12 students did a creative writing unit. They learned about the Freytag Model, Monomyth, the branches of genre within speculative fiction, and did a lot of writing. The final project for the unit was creating their own short story. The students created some fantastic work during this unit.
